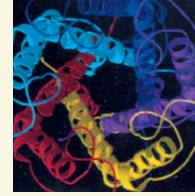

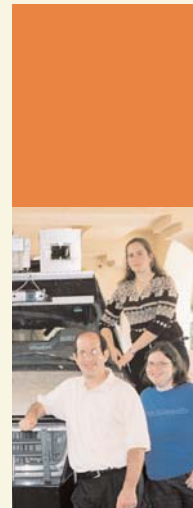

## BENEFITS OF MEMBERSHIP

Membership in the Caltech Corporate Affiliates Program is an excellent way for your corporation to engage with the entire Caltech community and complement any existing relationships you may already have with individual faculty members.
